*Traditions ensure heady aromas of spices and a long velvet character laden with warm fruit cake flavours.*

29. Barolo Lo Zoccolaio, Domini Villa Lanata £39.95  
**Italy**  
*Specially selected Nebbiolo grapes give heady aromas of violets and bramble berry characters enveloped in large oak barrique complexity, a classic from a top producer.*

30. Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Bolla £44.95  
**Italy**  
*The traditional method of semi-drying the grapes first ensures an enveloping, velvet richness with marzipan, raisin and date flavours.*

31. Brunello di Montalcino Greppone Mazzi Estate, Ruffino £54.95  
**Italy**  
*Typically intense, full-bodied and packed with ripe fruit, exhibits a complex perfumed aroma, grown on some of the region's highest vineyards.*

32. Torres Grans Muralles, Conca de Barberà £99.95  
**Spain**  
*A blend of ancient Catalan varieties like Monastrell, Garnacha, Garró, Samsó and Carriñena producing a rich, full-bodied wine with a warm spicy Mediterranean character.*

33. Bottega Brunello di Montalcino Riserva DOCG £120.00  
**Italy**  
*Elegant, balanced, velvety, well structured, dry and with a long aromatic persistence.*

34. Château Teyssier, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru £135.00  
**France**  
*A blend of 70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Franc - shows liquorice and dark berries on a softly textured palate.*

35. Luipardsberg Merlot 2001 £39.00  
**Durbanville Hills, South Africa**  
*Gold Veritas rich mulberry flavours and a presence of cherry and prunes, rounded off by a trace of oak-spice and vanilla*


36. Caapmans Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot 2000 £37.00  
**Durbanville Hills, South Africa**  
*Calyon Trophy Gold Medal Winner Rich flavours of berry, chocolate and spice gently laced with oak*

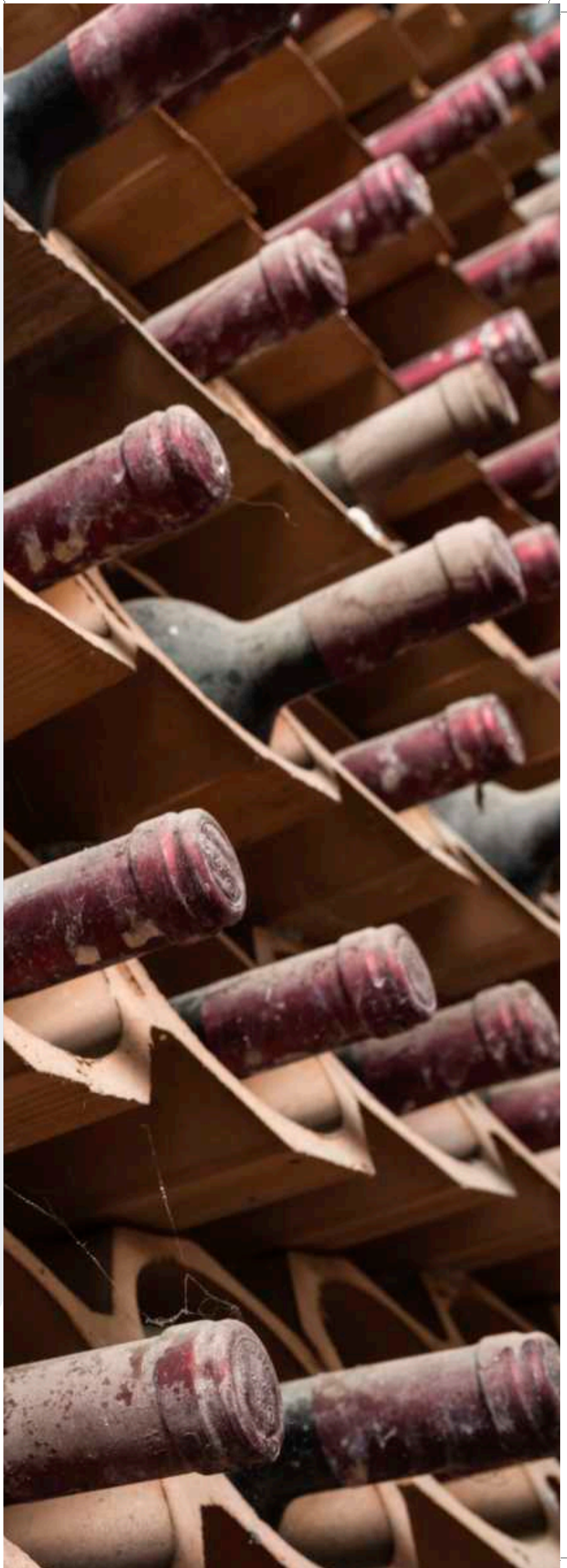
