*Shows apple and pear with hints of white peach and elderflower.* £20.00
3. Pulpo Albariño, Rías Baixas  
**Spain**  
*Aromas of white flowers, hints of peach and apricot lead to a fresh, fruity palate with an almost saline minerality.* £25.00
4. Gavi di Gavi Toledana, Domini Villa Lanata  
**Italy**  
*This excellent producer crafts this refreshing gooseberry and mineral style with delicate floral hints, dry but not austere.* £26.00
5. Chablis, Vignerons de Chablis  
**France**  
*Fresh, lively with a citrus and white blossom character backed by a finish tinged with minerality.* £29.95

*Harmonious and mellow, with violet and red berry notes on a soft and refreshing finish.*

*Soft, smooth, approachable Merlot with rounded cherries and spiced plums.*
19. Gran Volante Old Vine Garnacha, Calatayud £22.00  
**Spain**  
*Pronounced palate of raspberry, cherry and plum with notes of spice and leather.Full-bodied with fine, soft tannins and balanced acidity.*
20. Da Luca Nero d'Avola, Terre Siciliane £22.00  
**Italy**  
*Fresh cherry and bramble fruit aromas, followed by a note of vanilla on the finish.*
21. Don Jacobo Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Corral £25.95  
**Spain**  
*Traditional Rioja with a stylish, silky balance of ripe cherry flavours and generous vanilla-oak character for a mature style.*
22. Bourgogne Pinot Noir Couvent des Jacobins, Louis Jadot £29.95  
**France**  
*Layers of classic fresh strawberry aromas and plump soft cherries exude a light silky elegance.*
23. Chianti Classico, San Jacopo da Vicchiomaggio £25.95  
**Italy**  
*A soft, ripe and fruit-led wine with black cherry flavours and a soft touch of tannins.*
24. Fleurie Château de Fleurie, Domaine Loron £27.95  
**France**  
*Vibrancy of violet aromas and soft raspberry smoothness with a lingering elegance from 18th Century heritage and northern granite hills.*

### Spicy, peppery, warming red

27. Barbera d'Alba, Enrico Serafino £27.95  
**Italy**  
*Garnet-red, with a dry, quite full-bodied palate, it shows cherry, currant and spice.*

**Italy**  
*Specially selected Nebbiolo grapes give heady aromas of violets and bramble berry characters enveloped in large oak barrique complexity, a classic from a top producer.*
30. Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Bolla £44.95  
**Italy**  
*The traditional method of semi-drying the grapes first ensures an enveloping, velvet richness with marzipan, raisin and date flavours.*
31. Brunello di Montalcino Greppone Mazzi Estate, Ruffino £57.95  
**Italy**  
*Typically intense, full-bodied and packed with ripe fruit, exhibits a complex perfumed aroma, grown on some of the region's highest vineyards.*
33. Biondi – Santi DOCG 2004 Brunello Di – montalcino £120.00  
**Italy**  
*Elegant, balanced, velvety, well structured, dry and with a long aromatic persistence.*
34. Château Teyssier, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru £50.00  
**France**  
*A blend of 70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Franc - shows liquorice and dark berries on a softly textured palate.*
35. Luipardsberg Merlot 2001 £39.00  
**Durbanville Hills, South Africa**  
*Gold Veritas rich mulberry flavours and a presence of cherry and prunes, rounded off by a trace of oak-spice and vanilla*
36. Caapmans Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot 2000 £37.00  
**Durbanville Hills, South Africa**  
*Calyon Trophy Gold Medal Winner Rich flavours of berry, chocolate and spice gently laced with oak*

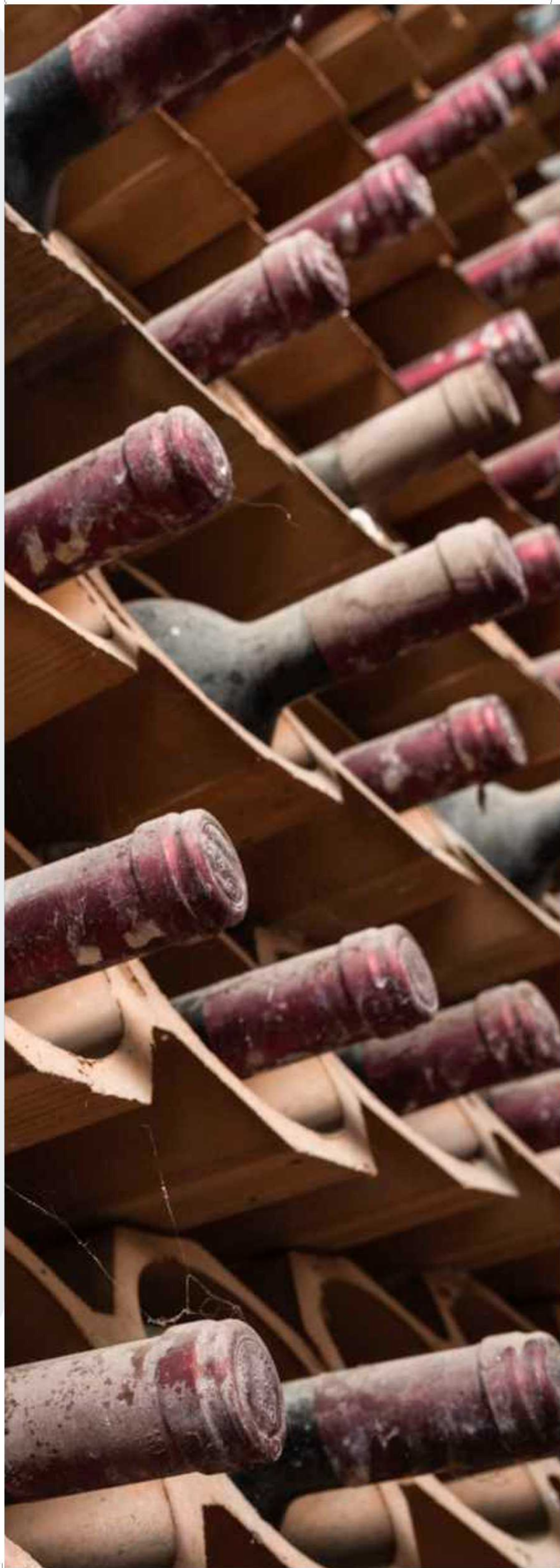
